Course Description

Students will use industry-standard multimedia and web-authoring software to create computer presentations and learn business-style presentation techniques. This project-based class begins with software basics and progresses to blend text, computer graphics or illustrations, and Internet research into a variety of business and cross-curricular presentations..

 - The ability to use Adobe Photoshop with a high skill level
 - The ability to use various hardware, including digital cameras, scanners, printers, computers
 - The ability to manipulate digital artwork and photographs
 - The ability to work within a team setting toward publishing the school's yearbook
 - The ability to create better designs in ads, documents, and more.

Grading:

Your grades will be based off of the following things:

- 1.) Weekly work
- 2.) Project printouts - grade points will vary according to the length and complexity of a particular project.
- 3.) Bi-weekly photograph & thumbnail printouts – 4 times per 6 weeks (every two weeks), select 10 of your best-manipulated photographs
- 4.) Assigned yearbook pages .
- 5.) Quarterly portfolio – all your finished projects and photo printouts
- 6.) Miscellaneous Assignments - Grade points will vary according to the length and complexity of a particular project.
